"Let no man deceive you by any means, for the Lord shall not come except there come a departure first, and that that sinful man be opened, the son of perdition,"

The Bishops Bible (1568)

"Let no man deceive you by any means, for [the Lord shall not come] except there come a falling away first, and that that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition,"

Geneva Bible (1599)

"Let no man deceive you by any means, for that day shall not come, except there come a departing first, and that the man of sin be disclosed, even the son of perdition,"
