
The Biblical Value of π

(1 Kings 7:23 & 2 Chronicles 4:2)

Consider:





Inputs: 30 cu = 30×18 in/cu = 540 in 10 cu = 10×18 in/cu = 180 in handbreadth = 4 in

Calculation:

$$\pi = \text{Circumference} \div (\text{Diameter} - 2 \times \text{Brim})$$

$$\pi = 540 \div (180 - 2 \times 4)$$

$$\pi = 3.14$$

Resolution of Apparent Contradiction:

1 Kings 7:26, "contained two thousand baths" = fill-level 2 Chronicles 4:5, "held three thousand baths" = capacity
